

How to get to ... The Tweed Hospital


By foot

The Tweed Hospital main entrance is located on Powell St near St Cuthbert's Anglican Church. It's an easy 10 minute walk from Wharf St and a 15 minute walk from Centro Tweed shopping mall.

By bicycle

A fantastic, scenic shared pathway extends along the Tweed river past the hospital. Off-road and on-road cycle pathways are also located around the perimeter of the hospital (see map overleaf).

 Bicycle parking is available at the main entrance to the hospital and behind the tower block, near the oncology unit.

By bus

Several bus routes travel to The Tweed Hospital from around the Tweed Shire. Bus routes 602 and 604 stop directly outside the main entrance to the hospital. Bus routes 601, 603, 605, 607 and 608 stop at Wharf St or at the bus inter-change at Centro Tweed shopping mall.

By carpool


Sharing the drive into The Tweed Hospital is a fun way to save money, meet new people and reducing your carbon footprint.

You can register online with the Northern Rivers carpooling service (www.nrcarpool.org). A designated meeting place is located near the rear hospital car park.

By car

If you plan on driving to the hospital, be mindful that there are a limited number of untimed car spaces available.

Two hour street parking spots are available around the hospital grounds, but give yourself plenty of time to find a parking space.

 Disabled car parking is available near the main entrance to the hospital.

By taxi

Taxis can be booked for pick up at the Main entrance by calling Tweed Heads Taxis on 13 34 22 or 13 10 08. Alternatively, a taxi rank is located at the entrance to Centro Tweed shopping mall.
